Average amount of student loan debt accrued by Jung Tao School students

- Jung Tao School was initially approved to offer Title IV financial aid in 2010-2011 school year. Prior to that time no Title IV financial aid was available to Jung Tao School students.
- Three students in the 2011 graduating class completed the program with student loan debt. The median loan debt for these students was \$10,200.
